

Parts Of Computers



Name computer units defined below:

1. I/O DEVICES, also known as PERIPHERALS: keyboard, mouse, scanner, printer, speakers, etc.
2. The “heart” of the computer - a microprocessor chip that processes data and coordinates the activities of other units: CPU
3. collective name for all the electronic / mechanical parts of a computer: hardware
4. collective name for all the programs: software
5. Collective name for all the units where we keep data and programs: storage
6. Any socket into which a peripheral device may be connected: port

Confusables

- ▶ HARDWARE or HARDWEAR?
- ▶ HARDWARE but FOOTWEAR
- ▶ WARE (n.) – goods for sale, merchandize
 - ▶ WEAR (n.) – clothes
- ▶ DISC or DISK
 - ▶ DISC if optical, refers to music or sport
- ▶ DISK – more commonly related to computers, even though DISC is also used

Information

- uncountable noun
 - An information
 - Informations

- Instead:
a piece / several pieces of information

DATA vs INFORMATION

DATA

- ▶ raw, unorganized facts that need to be processed.

INFORMATION

- ▶ when data is processed, organized, structured or presented in a given context so as to make it useful, it is called *information*.

compute

vs

computerize (US) / computerise (UK)

- They've just COMPUTERIZED the whole system.

(= used a computer to do something that was done by people or other machines before)

- The bank clerk will COMPUTE the interest on your loan.
(= calculate)
